Congratulations! You have been chosen by your school to attend The Association of Catholic Student Councils Twenty-Seventh Annual Summer Leadership Conference to be held at Claremont McKenna College in Claremont, CA. Our conference will begin with registration between 1:00 and 3:00 pm. on Wednesday, July 15, 2009. At that time room assignments will be made. Copies of the program schedule will be distributed to each delegate.

At 3 o'clock we will bid your families "goodbye" and invite them to return for the conclusion of our conference at 12:30 pm. on July 19th when we will celebrate Sunday Mass.

Print them, acquire the necessary signatures and send them to the TACSC office by **JULY 1, 2009**. If you have not already done so, please send the balance of your fee as well.

In order for us to consider you a **CONFIRMED** participant in our conference we must have these papers and payment for the full amount in the TACSC office by July 1st. **NO STUDENT WILL BE ALLOWED TO STAY AT THE CONFERENCE SITE** if these requirements have not been met **PRIOR** to the start of the conference. *(Your place will likely be given to someone on our waiting list if we do not have your paperwork and full fees by July 1st.)*

A **\$25** late fee (per student) must be included with any payment and papers received after July 1st.. (To avoid this late charge and assure that **TACSC** has your papers in time to process them before the conference, please consider sending your papers **overnight US MAIL**.)

The conference fee includes room, board, special programs, a conference T-shirt, notebook and all school supplies needed during your stay. Bring only a minimum amount of spending money (small bills and change). You might want a candy bar or beverage. If you plan to phone home, you will need change or a phone card. Please, **no gum**.

Our staff will include teachers, college and high school students experienced in Student Government. We know you will find them both friendly and helpful, ready to share terrific techniques and super ideas. **Take advantage of opportunities you have to talk with our staff about your particular office, school, and student council.** Find out what advice they have to offer toward developing your talents and making your weaknesses into strengths. **REMEMBER!** Your principal and student council moderator will be expecting you to put into practice the things you will be learning at the conference.

Come prepared to get the most out of what should be a valuable, and lots of fun, kind of learning experience. Make up your mind ahead of time to really **GET INVOLVED**.
